They put me on the ambulance, and I'm in the ambulance, and the guy said He's gone, he's gone, and I'm watching it. And I thought, God, where I hadn't registered the fact that I was floating above my body, that I was going to the hospital, that had not registered with me. I was still feeling the place that I was and the safety and the comfort that I had. Then all of a sudden, when he said he's gone, I could sense this tunnel forming over my left shoulder, and I could sense it. And then I look, and then all of a sudden, I start moving down this tunnel, now coming to this place of light. I mean, beautiful, golden, silvery, like those blue is silvery light, and this being comes close to me as though to make me feel comfortable. But wherever I was was better than where I lived.

Make life review, which is the single most important thing anybody listening tonight should get you will see your entire life pass before you in a 360 degree panorama. You will watch it from a second person point of view, as though you were your own best friend. And then you will literally become every person that you ever encounter, and you will feel the direct results of your interaction between you and that person. Nobody gets away with anything, and it's never about what you do. It's about why you do it. And somewhere in that conversation, you will ask yourself this one question, if the divine or if God couldn't come today and God sent you in the life you just reviewed, what difference did you and God make? I became a hospice volunteer because knowing what I knew about being dead when I could walk, what I could do about being dead, and what I knew about veterans, because I'm an old Marine, and what I knew about veterans that I could make a difference in the life. So I created the Twilight brigade, which became one of the largest end of life care volunteer program for dying veterans in American history. And then I co wrote the standard end of life care model for the Veterans Administration. And now I'm working on the brakeley Foundation, which is about using energetics. We have to look at the ethereal, spiritual nature of beings, and we have to look at it. I look at traumatic brain injury that is a that is more than a chemical problem. It's an energetic, frequency harmonic problem. And so thanks for putting me on Chris, because absolutely anyone can look at this and see where I'm going and what I'm doing, contribute support, keep up to date, ask questions, and do all that, because if I can affect traumatic brain injury, then I'm going to reduce the amount of suicide rates among the veterans that are passing today. And we only have, like, 18,000 veterans left, I mean, mostly Vietnam, but there's about 28 killing themselves every day. Yeah, that if I can reduce that number by one or two, then I think I'm being successful, and I think I have a pathway and a program that will achieve it.

Your heart beats between 94,000 and 104,000 times a day, your body has to produce somewhere close to 45 millivolts of a current in order to make your heart beat. So when you start to tell me you're not electrical B, you're holding yourself, but talking to each other, and you have to produce 100,000 times a day, you got to produce x amount of voltage. So your heart will beat and your cells can sustain 70 to 90 millivolts.

Okay, so after six, after seven days of covenant going I go into reset resuscitation, I'd be resuscitated. Wow, Sunday morning at 2am and I went out, and they went to banging on my chest, and I came out of my body, and I stood next to the charge nurse. Here I am. Here's the charge nurse. I'm looking down at them pounding on my body and recessive trying to resuscitate me. And the little cardiologist, she's yelling at me, she's screaming at me, and I knew each person would one would get tired of being on my chest. I knew who replaced the next one, and then I knew who replaced that one, and I could know that. And then they brought me back. I came back. I stayed six or seven minutes, and then I flat lined again. All this is like 45 to 50 minutes, and they had to resuscitate me again. I came out again. I never went anywhere. I don't I mean, I'm dead on the table and I'm having to be resuscitated, but I don't call that. That is not a near death experience to me. That's an out of body experience. It might have happened when I was dead, but nonetheless, when you wait, I think what you like about me, Chris is, I'm always straight. That's just it.

But whenever you go out to do stuff, do you do you ever hear reports or get reports from the locals? Have you ever talked to the local indigenous people? And he's like, yes, and they see him all the time. The difference is for them, it's regular. There's there's normal. Yeah, it's been there for generations.

They respect it, and we have to respect it. You know, on that we have, we're very close to the muscalara reservation. And sometimes some people from the reservation do come to my meetings, and you know, especially my limb Buchanan meeting, they came to that a lot. And, you know, we have to follow that with them.

And I wish I could probe it. I had one witness one time come to a MUFON meeting and tell me he worked at White Sands, in janitorial. He was in maintenance. I'm sorry, maintenance, not janitorial, but he was telling me, you know, there's an underground there's an underground railroad under the base there. You know that, don't Yeah. And I'm like, show me where it is. And, yeah, show me entrance on there.

I I've spent a lot of time and a lot of efforts, boots on the ground, chasing the evidence down for the Holloman landing and the the I've always been trying to prove that the Holloman landing wasn't on April 30, 1964 and we really gotta move on. Really got a big date, big break in April of 2019 when the Holloman base commander's son came to our MUFON meeting, and he stood up and he said that he knew that the Holloman landing was true because his father was the base commander when it happened. What? And yeah, his father was the base commander. And his father told him that he saw the aliens meet with the general and Dr Steinhoff that time, and he pointed to a building on base, which he referred to as the Mars shack. So I wasn't familiar with the Mars shack, and I had to hunt that down. And it took me until 2023 to determine exactly that building 930 was the Mars shack. Now here's a here's a good picture of it. That's a map of if you go into the Holloman Air Force Base Visitor Center, that map is up on the wall, and that's where I took a picture of it, and I put a red arrow there, pointing to that building that's building 930 building 930 is what's referred to as MARS station. A lot of people call it that, but I wanted to show that to you in the drawing the Holloman landing goes that the the craft landed on North ramp. If you can go back to that other image real quick. Chris, this the object at the top. You'll say it says North, South, East, one way, it's at the very top, that's where the aliens landed, and that's referenced in Jacques Ballet's book. Revelations that they landed on the Tor map on the west end of the base. Then the aliens were taken to what's called King one. And you'll see there's a word on there that says runway access. That area right there is where King one is, and that's the security forces station. If you're up range at Holloman and you're going to come down into the base proper, you've got to go through that security forces gate, and they refer to it as King one. So in Jean plays book, he said that the aliens were taken to King one, where they met with the base commander, the chief scientist, and they spoke to the aliens that had come off the craft. And then they were taken to building 930 at the end of mars Street. And on that map there that building at the end of Mars Street is building 930 which is referred to as the Mars shack. So this image you see here is a Google Map Image, a Google Earth image. I wanted to get the clearest view I could of the that building 930 which number one top? That's a that's just a Google Earth image that's from 2016 you see the number two at the bottom. That's what it looks like. Now, because they removed that building in 2023 they excavated it. The only thing left is the big fence that you see around the outside edge of it, but I was able to locate this picture that's on the other side of the image. It says MARS station, and you can clearly see that that shape with the bump out in the back, matches the image and from the Google Earth map. Now also, I have an eyewitness. Well, I was trying to find out what a Mars shack is. I didn't know what that was. Sure, you know it kind of, it kind of, I just didn't know what the terminology was. So I decided to ask someone who I know, who worked on face who said who was a ham radio operator. And I asked him, I'm not going to say his name, but I asked him, you know what a Mars? What does Mars stand for? And he said, Oh, that's the military auxiliary radio system, yeah. Now that was part of every military base have a MARS station. And what it was is, if there was a

natural disaster, hurricane or whatnot, knocked out all the communications, you could go to the MARS station, and the old antenna was there, and you could, you can make communication. But more importantly, if you were stationed at a base, and maybe you lived in Maine, and you were stationed in New Mexico and you wanted to call your mom long distance calls. Charges were terrible back in the day. So you could go to the bar station and you can make a long distance call back home and tell your mom you're okay. Or, if you were in Vietnam during the Vietnam War, they could call home and let just people know, hey, I'm fine. Yeah, yeah, don't worry about me. It was, it was a godsend the MARS station, but they're not used anymore. With the advent of digital technology and cell phones, not anybody can make a long distance call and it doesn't cost a dime. Yeah, yeah, the Mars stations were pretty much eradicated from the basis because they didn't need them anymore because of the satellite technology and the digital technology. So that's why that Mars shack was removed from that that location, right there on the base. But the guy I asked, he said to me, he says, it's funny you say that. He said, I he worked for the Civil Engineering Department at home, and he said, I just had the Mars shack removed. And he said, a real funny thing. He said I had the Mars shack removed, and I had a pile of rocks on top of it that won't be moved for 100 years. And I thought that was a funny statement. And he didn't know I was involved with MUFON or anything like that. I was honestly just asking him, because I didn't I was trying to educate myself as to what a MARS station was. Well, once he told me that I realized that that would be the I realized that that was building 930 when he told me that, because I could look on map, it's there in the visitor center, and I knew exactly where building 930 was. I drove out there myself. I couldn't believe it that I finally found the Mars Jack. And when I got out there, he was right, that building was gone. There was nothing but a pile of rocks there. The gates were thrown open. I drove my car in there. I got out. I wanted you just to look at this picture one more time and look at the side view. When they said that the aliens were taken to building 930 and they spoke with the base commander, there was a lot of speculation that there was an underground base, or there was a room underneath the Mars shack, and that's where they were taken to, because in valet's book, he actually says they stayed there for two or three years, translating for the Americans. But I looked at that picture, and I can, I could tell by looking at that picture, there's there's no underground shaft, there's no underground room. You can see, it's just up on blocks. And actually myself, I ran around that that yard. After I got in there, I was so excited, and I looked for signs of excavation or filling in a hole or a dip, anything that would have shown that there possibly had been something under that building, and there wasn't. And the picture, I found, the picture recently that in the last year, the that old Polaroid, that all Polaroid was no mediator for me to look at, but I'm confident that that that's from probably the 70s or 80s. Old 35 millimeter film, you know, developed Holloman had the

development capabilities. That's why the everything was that was pictures that were taken at White Sands Missile Range, a film that was taken at White Sands Missile Range, the crew from Holloman shop news, because they had access to the development equipment, and they had that dark room. They were the ones that did that line of stuff, and they did that at the Holloman Air Force Base. So that's how the all the films and whatnot ended up down there. But you know the story, the story itself of the Holloman landing was that three objects were above Holloman Air Force Base. One landed on the tarmac. The aliens came out. One was carrying a staff of some sort, the base commander, the chief scientist, and someone from security forces, I believe, went up to them, and they were able to communicate with the base commander through the staff. The staff was some type of translation device. They were taken to King one. The aliens went to building 930 and their craft, the UFO, was taken to building 830 where it was unloaded. Now that's referenced in Jack Ballet's books, that was referenced in Timothy goods books. Also when you go back and you go back to the very beginning, and you go back to April 30, 1964 apro, the aerial phenomenon research organization, they first there was a landing at Holloman in the May 1964 at World bulletin. Then they also in that bulletin that just that month was The Socorro landing. So the main bulletin was full more of the Socorro information when the July bulletin came out that was full of the Holloman landing and all their information and all their evidence that they had collected. And they spoke to fps, 16 radar operators, who told them that they saw the crafts on radar that day and the time 5:45am that also correlates with Jeff valets book. Well, ja filet was a DOD contractor. He worked for Project Blue Book with Dr Heineck get access to all that information. So the fact that his book matches the data is, is, is, is great, and that was the only evidence we had, and until we got the MUFON affidavit in 2019 who was sitting in the MUFON meeting, Don gave a wonderful presentation regarding some evidence he had found regarding the Holloman landing. He asked if anyone had anything to add. Guy stood up, said he was the son of the base commander. The base commander's name was Henry Godman, and his son, Lou was there that day. He told us that he had driven his father on base. His father was ill. He was dying of cancer, and he loved the base. His father loved the base. He wanted to get cheered up, so Lou put him in the car. They went over to base. When they were driving around base, his father asked him to stop. He pointed to the building. He said that is where the general and Dr Steinhauer met with the aliens that time, right there in the Mars shack. And Lou was kind of amazed by it, because his father really didn't talk about his his stuff when he was on base. He kept it, you know, pretty much to himself, but that's what he told him that day, and I will we were shocked with the meeting. You know, Don took him and interviewed him, and he actually had the physical. He had an affidavit in his hand, a notarized document with that statement on it. The other statement, yeah, the other statement that Lou had is that he remembered, as a child, when they lived on base, the red phone ringing. The red phone he wasn't supposed to touch. It rang one night, woke the whole house up. His father ran out, and the next day, when his father came back, Lou had found out from his father whether his father was talking to his mother or what. Told him that he had to leave in a hurry because security forces had saw a UFO land on base, and he had to go out and investigate it. Now he has that memory as a child, and he put it together when his father, in 1995 told him about communicating with the aliens that had landed on base, kind of when he put those, those two, those two things that had happened in his life together, and thought that they were related well.

yes, well, he did die shortly after that, Lou said that his father loved the Air Force. He loved Holloman. After he retired, he stayed there, he stayed here with his family. You know, he really was a local, a locally, well known individual. And I thought this was really I said, Okay, well, I've got to vet this. This information on this thing, I have to find out. Okay, was Henry Godman really the base commander? And when was he the base commander? Does the dates match up? Because Lou wasn't certain of the date that his father didn't tell him the date that it had happened, but when I went to look it up, I couldn't find any evidence of Henry Godman being the colonel at Holloman Air Force Base. I went to Holloman Air Forces bases website the past. Commanders. He wasn't listed. I went to the 49th wing building. They have a giant mural on the wall at the 49th wing building, and it has every aircraft that ever flew on Holloman. It has a timeline with every commander line, with every commander on it, not Henry Godman. So believe it or not, I found reference that he was at Holloman. I found it on Wikipedia, which I don't believe anything I find on Wikipedia. So I really, really had to drill into that a whole lot more, because I couldn't believe it. But I went to the Holloman I'm sorry. I went to the Alamogordo library, and they had microfiche for all the Alamogordo daily local news is and I started ripping through. I started ripping through those things to the 19 to April of 1964 no mention of the Holloman landing. Of course, interesting. I went about a year into it, and it had the retirement of Colonel Henry Godman, the retirement party that is huge retirement party for Henry Godman, this town loved the man on the Civic Center had his retirement party in July of 1965 so I was able, once I found that little nugget, I was able to really drill in and find that he was stationed in Holloman, 1963 to 1965 he retired after 29 years in the Air Force at Holloman. He retired, he kept his family here in his retirement party, the mayor, the senator, the governor, the people from the Joint Chiefs of Staff. He was a really big deal in the Air Force, and I was like, why isn't he anywhere at Holloman? Why isn't the board? Why isn't he on the website? I started snooping around all air force bases. They name everything after somebody. Every streets named after somebody that was there. Every building conference rooms are even named after people, but not Henry Godman. Now I found that there's a memorial garden next to the officers club named after Dr Steinhoff, the Chief Scientist, huh? I told that. Well, we got Dr Steinhoff, but we don't have, we don't have Colonel garden, and that's really, really strange. But I dug around a little more and I was able to find I have a copy of it. I don't think I gave you a copy of this. He had written a book called The Supreme Commander. Oh, it's terrible.
